

"N" Bowl Replacement

Replacing a damaged bowl requires careful planning. The bowl needs to be properly supported during removal. Drill 1/4" diameter holes around the bowl just inside the edge of the recessed faucet landing as shown in drawing No.1. Saw at balanced intervals between the drilled holes to remove the bowl. See drawing No. 2. Drop in the replacement bowl to check the fit. There will be a bowl to deck overlap of approximately 1/2" which provides a bonding interface for silicone sealant. Tape off and sand the overlapping surfaces for a correct bond. Apply silicone and install the bowl. Re-connect the plumbing after the sealant has cured.
